### **District Chief Meeting Minutes**

# June 8th, 9th, 13th, 2017 Meeting

#### Fire Prevention

- Building with all elevators OOS- you must write an Order To Comply (OTC).
- Fire watch- difference between under 10 hours and over 10 hours. All require an OTC, fire watch over 10 hours requires District Chief, Shift Commander, and FPB Chief involvement.
- Notes on inspections only enter items such as occupancy changes, building demolished, etc. Don't put violations in the notes section.
- OTC's email address: <u>denfpb@denvergov.org</u>, please copy A/C Vigil and make email and pictures legible.
- FDC keys make sure you have a dog bone key that opens the FDC locking devices. This is the same key that will open highway water access panels.

# Dispatch and Response Items

- Water Assist Calls- may not be necessary to send entire dive team on all water calls during a storm, depends on situation, nature of call, etc. Shift Commander, District Chiefs can use discretion on this.
- Group Responses- respect call for radio silence from the fire dispatchers.
- Elevator Response- if response turns technical, call for entire high angle team. Consideration is being given to Rescue 1 no longer be automatically dispatched to an elevator rescue in a high rise.
- Fire Dispatch- do not use long ring unnecessarily.
- Hamer 1 We are looking into removing Hamer 1 off of inside natural gas leaks.
- "Slumpers" Denver Police and the 911 center have added a specific nature code that will elicit a higher priority response for these calls.

# <u>Med 1</u>

- We are currently reviewing the area and types of calls that the Med Unit goes on.
- The Med Unit should not be assigned to cardiac issues, assaults, violent patients, or any other type of call that would benefit from a 4-person company.
- The response area is roughly between Stations 1, 4, and 8. Calls outside of this area by a few blocks are OK but in general, Med Unit stays in this area.

### ETAC1

• New radio channel being used by DHMC for ambulances that are assigned to calls. This channel will be patched to our TAC 9.

#### Live MUM

• LiveMUM should be accessible on all District Chief's computers. Do not stay logged onto Live MUM, you can stay logged onto the static MUM (we have limited user licenses).

### **Cybersecurity Mandatory Training**

• This is mandatory training again this year for all members.

### **Employee Engagement Survey**

• All members need to fill out this survey. You should have received information about this survey by email.

# **Target Solutions**

- All supervisors need to go online and login to this software.
- The next step will allow all members to create a login.
- We expect all training to be logged in Target Solutions in the future beginning around August 1st.
- We are working on buying a mobile training center for all firehouses.

# **Ladder Compliment**

• Consideration if being given to spec out the new trucks to enable the use of a 45' ladder. Due to the configuration of our current ladder compartments ladders of this length will not fit.

## **Turnout Times**

- The reserve air/light does not have a cascade system.

## **EMS**

- The current iPad tablets will still be used for inspections.
