## - DPD - Calling on their Dist. Channels

- o Review Communication SOG 2107.06.
- o Talking with DPD on their channels will expedite their arrival.

#### Wild land 2014

- o Pre-hiring of OT for Wild land will be utilized this year.
- If a member is sent home due to a returning deployment use position for position as the means to cancel the hiring.
- The new type 3 engine will be in service mid-summer. It can be used for brush fires when it's here at home.

## Time Trade Policy

- o District Chiefs have reviewed the policy and provided input.
- Policy will then be released to the Division for member review and will go "live" soon after.

# - Transfer Policy

#### - iPad Airs

## **OPERATIONS TRAINING**

- TCC Training is Underway
  - o Registration of members has been completed by Ops

    - Due to advance registration, there will be some days select personnel will be different than those registered. Ops will keep track of these.

## - FIRE PREVENTION

- Inspections
  - Inspection completion progress Everyone should be well underway. Some companies haven't started and they need to start ASAP.
  - o iPad Chargers. Remember that chargers are the responsibility of the Captains and they will be held accountable for this equipment.
  - Referrals to Bureau Make sure to notify District Fire Prevention Chiefs when referrals are made via the ipads.

## - SAFETY ISSUES

- None were raised at this time except for the wearing of SCBA's.

## SAFETY AND TRAINING DIVISION

- June In-Service Training. Looking at this training dovetailing off of the SCBA / RIT in-service that Chief Murphy gave to companies recently.
- Fitness Assessments.
  - o Starting up this month in Districts 4 and 5.
  - Districts 3 and 7 are scheduled for August.
  - Assessments will impact firehouses for about 3 days. Lt. Shawn Brooks will coordinate for setup and takedown of equipment with house Captains.
  - Plans are underway to standardize the Fitness Assessment schedule for each vear.
  - Face piece fit testing will not be conducted during fitness assessments. It will take place during in-service training instead.

- The Dept. physical therapist will be getting an extension to his contract. This treatment has been based on the model that professional sports teams use for athletes and has let to very good outcomes for the members that have used the service.
- Training asked for input from the Chiefs for training that members would like to see.

# **FIRE PREVENTION BUREAU**

- Current Issues Chief Ellis
  - Referrals FPB is working on Several Occupancies, such as those that are generating excessive nuisance alarms from refuge areas.

# TECHNICAL SERVICES / DISPATCH

- Company Move-Up.
  - The department is looking into the possibility of a CAD module that can assist with relocating companies around the city during large incidents.
  - Other systems may have viability
  - o The last option may be to update the old run cards system.
  - When companies are asked to relocate, they are expected to do so immediately.
- MDT's and the new upgrade.
  - The night setting on the screen does not work correctly. This will be addressed in the next update.
