SUBJECT: ACTIVE SHOOTER TRAINING

Do you know what to do if you're involved in an active shooter situation while off duty? Getting trained is your best defense. All City and County of Denver employees can now be trained on how to defend themselves in the event of an active shooter situation through an instructor-led training or through an online course in CityU.

Webb Building training sessions presented by the Denver Police Department and Risk Management will be held throughout the month of June for Workplace Safety Month. The CityU course will be available all year long to help empower employees to protect themselves in the event of an active shooter situation.
