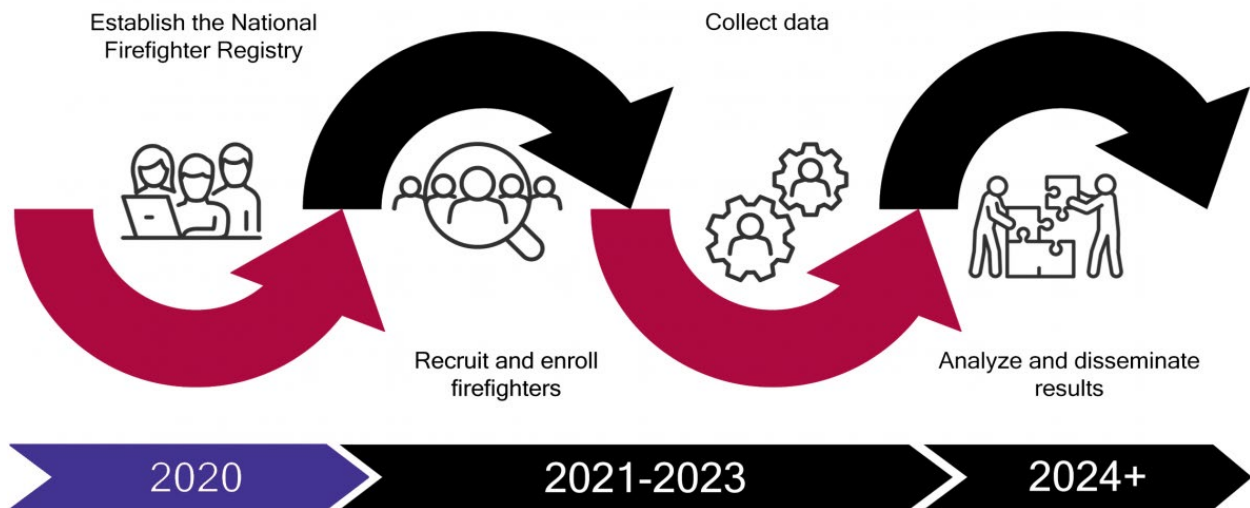


Timeline
